

Instructions for applying the most current patch.

### Step 1: Obtain The Latest Files

Step 1a: From Our ftp site

Go to our ftp site - ftp://ftp.abn.state.al.us  
user name - ceproviders  
password - abnupload

Download the following folders to your PC:

ABN\_1.2.0  
ABN\_1.2.2 Patch  
MDAC 2-8 Version

Remember where you save them. The default is your desktop, but you can save it somewhere else if you want.

Step 1b: From CD

We have started sending the CD to new providers in the box with the TriCorder.

Others may request the CD by contacting the Board.

### Step 2: Install The Software

Open the folder "ABN\_1.2.0" and run "setup.exe". This will install/reinstall the most recent version of the program. When it asks you if you want to keep your old database, you must answer yes or you will lose all of your old file information. If your current files are installed on a network, you must reinstall to the network location and everyone who uses the software must upgrade as well.

### Step 3: Apply The Patch

In the folder "ABN\_1.2.2 Patch", there is a file called "abn.exe", copy/save it to the installation directory - if you used the installation file defaults, your installation directory will be "C:\Program Files\ABN". If your current files are installed on a network, you must copy this file to the network installation location. It is not necessary for every user on the network to do this step.

It will tell you that the file already exists and ask if you want to overwrite the file. Answer "yes" or "OK" or

whatever the choice is to overwrite the file.

Once you have applied the patch, you can use the program like normal.

Step 4: OPTIONAL - Install MS Data Access Components  
Additionally, you may have to apply the MDAC update from Microsoft. Open the folder "MDAC 2-8 Version" and run the program called "MDAC\_TYP.EXE". This will update your Data Access Components. If you have multiple users sharing the files on a network, all users will have to run this update.
