

Alabama Board of Nursing Otolaryngology Specialty

The Otolaryngology Specialty Protocol for Collaborative Practice Nursing lists the skills/procedures below that are approved to apply for through an application process. The application and instructions are available on the ABN website at Otolaryngology Protocol Application.

Practice Settings: Restricted to Otolaryngology practice

Population Foci: Family, Adult Acute Care, Adult Gerontology/Acute Care, Adult/Gerontology Primary Care, Gerontology, Pediatric, and Pediatric Acute Care

Initial Requirements:

- 1. CRNP has worked in the clinical setting of otolaryngology for no less than six months prior to making a request to train.
- 2. CRNP has observed no fewer than <u>150 of each procedure requested</u> (including normal/abnormal tissue distinction) *prior to* requesting authorization to train to perform the procedure.
- 3. Collaborating physician completes a request to train after the observation period is completed.

Procedures included:

- 1. Flexible Fiberoptic Diagnostic Laryngoscopy/Stroboscopy
- 2. Flexible Nasopharyngoscopy
- 3. Diagnostic Nasal Endoscopy (flexible and rigid)

Requirement Prior to Requesting to Train	Initial Requirement for Certification	Annual Maintenance Requirement
Observation of no fewer than 150 of each procedure requested	Perform and document 25 proctored procedures	Perform and document no fewer than 25 proctored procedures yearly

^{**}Supervised practice must be submitted within one year of approval to train.
