Certified Registered Nurse Practitioners (CRNP) Certified Nurse Midwife (CNM)

Controlled Drug Certificate Protocol

Eligible: CRNP and CNM

Application/Rules:

The CRNP and CNM may complete an application with the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners (ABME) for a Qualified Alabama Controlled Substance Certificate (QACSC). Limitations:

The authority of a CRNP or CNM to prescribe, administer, authorize for administration or dispense pursuant to a QACSC is limited to those controlled substances enumerated in Schedules III, IV and V.

ABME Required Documentation:

- Completion of the CME course, Prescribing Controlled Drugs, jointly sponsored by the Board and MASA (eight credits), and documentation of completion of four Category 1 credits in advanced pharmacology and controlled substances prescribing trends. The ABME/MASA course includes the required eight-credit prescribing course and a four-credit advanced pharmacology/prescribing trends course).
- Provide documentation of a minimum of 12 months of active clinical practice pursuant to an approved collaborative practice agreement (temporary and provisional approval practice time may not be used).
